Mains'l is finalizing revisions to our **Safe Transportation Policy**. We have updated our points system and all employees will need to provide insurance proof through CDS. Per our insurance carrier, we will be placing GPS trackers in all Mains'l vehicles by end of July. Please be on the look out in your CDS tasks for a copy of the policy and an acknowledgement that you have received and reviewed it.



Reminder, we have assigned a vehicle safety training to all employees on CDS. Employees who work at a CRS home were assigned a similar training that was combined with home maintenance topics. These trainings will be reassigned annually.
