

JOB DESCRIPTION

MAINS'L MISSION TEAM MEMBER

JOB SUMMARY:

This is a voluntary position working with our charitable partners as a member of the Mains'l Mission Team (M2T). This position requires a one year commitment to the Mission Team, attending intermittent team meetings pre- and post-trip, international travel for up to three weeks, performing volunteer work involving physical labor, critical thinking and problem solving, teaching and learning, and related project activities as assigned. Team members must personally raise a portion of the cost of travel, prior to departure. Upon return, M2T members participate in the evaluation of the Mains'l global leadership program and selection of team members for the following year. Using the experience and enhanced leadership skills developed throughout the mission team commitment, members will make a conscious effort to put into practice what they have learned on a daily basis, as well as participate in efforts to continue to "pay it forward." Team members identify SMART goals within 20 days of return from mission trip, including ways to apply what was learned from the experience at work, home, community, and global. Members are expected to model for all members of the crew what it means to be a global servant leader, and to further the mission and values of Mains'l Services upon return.

Provide support to projects identified by our charitable partners on the mission trip, while contributing to the efforts of sustainability.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Work with local partners, providing support to the identified projects, in a non-intrusive and respectful manner
 - Complete tasks that are assigned
 - Willing to try new tasks
 - Maintain flexibility moving from one job to the next
 - Engage others in problem solving on the job to gain ownership
2. Maintain professional demeanor by observing Mains'l standards of conduct, behaving with transparency and integrity at all times
 - Work cooperatively with all team members
 - Possess strong servant leader beliefs
 - Ability to trust and be vulnerable with team members
 - Be respectful of all team members
 - Engage in positive appropriate conflict resolution as needed
 - Willing to support fellow team members in their projects
 - Working together as team "we"
 - Participate in feedback sessions
3. Engage with local community members, following their cultural standards.
 - Gain knowledge of local traditions and customs
 - Respectful of and embrace local traditions and customs
 - Open and responsive to all community members
4. Commitment to charitable giving of time, talent, and treasure
 - Practice servant leadership
 - Participate in elder or child sponsorship and/or other charitable giving
